

# Dual Tire Chain Mounting

- MAKE SURE TIRE CHAIN IS NOT TWISTED



- Pick-up chain set by center rail and drape over the outside dual tire.
- Next grab the top outside rail and lay over the inter dual tire.
- Confirm that all side rails and hooks are straight.
- Pull forward about 2-3 ‘
- Connect center rail first, make sure the extra links are pull back before hooking the link.
- Connect inside rail 2<sup>nd</sup>, the connection should be snug. Then turn the cam’s to tighten.
- Next connect the outside rail, again make sure the extra links are pull back before connecting.
- Turn cam’s to tighten.
- Drive forward 10-20’ retighten cam’s for snug fit.
- IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A SUNG FIT TIGHTEN THE INNER AND OUTER RAIL AGAIN.
- Still not tight then, If the connection is connected next to a crosslink with no room for more adjustment, then you will need to remove the last two crosslinks on both sides at the end of the 3 rails.
